
Colorado Traditional Archers Society YOUTH HUNT

CTAS provides hunting licenses, food, lodging in wall tents, hunting blinds and mentors.

Loaner bows are available.

A parent or legal guardian must accompany the youth camp.

Warm clothes and a warm sleeping bag are necessary.

We have hunted in snow.

The hunt takes place southwest of Grand Junction on a private ranch. Youth will hunt mule deer does with traditional equipment. Youth must be 12-17 years old, a Colorado resident, must have their hunter safety card, never have taken a big game animal with traditional equipment, and be able to pull 35 pounds and shoot accurately by the hunt date.

The hunt is tentatively planned **for October 3-6, 2024**. Participants are required to furnish their own transportation to and from the hunt and must meet at the Colorado Parks and Wildlife Grand Junction Office, 711 Independent Ave, at 3 p.m. on October 3rd to go through the big game licensing process. Thursday evening dinner will be served at camp **followed by a mandatory safety/orientation seminar.** Hunting will be from Friday morning through about noon on Sunday. Hunters, parents, and mentors will stay in heated wall tents. CTAS will provide food and licenses. Youth hunters and parents need to bring a **warm sleeping bag** and personal gear including **cold weather clothing**. A maximum of 6 youth hunters will be selected to participate in the hunt.
